in the German-Speaking Territories (1500-1550):  
Two Viennese Case-Studies**

This paper examines the circumstances which led Latin works of Italian origin to receive attention in Renaissance Vienna. In my presentation I shall be looking at the ways in which two editions of Angelo Poliziano’s writings (the “*Lamia*” and the “*Nutricia*”) were produced in the city in the first half of the sixteenth century by two “local” humanists, Joannes Alexander Brassicanus and Joannes Ludovicus Brassicanus.
