

AN UNKNOWN POEM ON THE SACK OF ROME ATTRIBUTED TO ANDRÉ DE RESENDE

In this talk, Maria Czepiel presents a newly discovered Latin ode attributed to André de Resende (1498–1573), a prominent Iberian humanist and ‘the best Latin poet produced by Portugal’. In the first place, she addresses the question of transmission and authorship. She also explores what the poem can tell us about humanist responses to the Sack of Rome, one of the most traumatic events of European history in the sixteenth century.
