Stephen Harrison (University of Oxford)



Stephen Harrison is Professor of Latin Literature at the University of Oxford and Senior Research Fellow at Corpus Christi College. In Neo-Latin studies, he has published on Latin texts from the baroque period, especially from Italy (his The Neo-Latin Verse of Urban VIII, Alexander VII and Leo XIII appeared this year). During his research stay in Innsbruck, he worked on George Buchanan (1506–1582). In his talk, he will focus on the multiple identities of this Scottish, French, European writer, present his oeuvre, and focus especially on the Silvae collection, which he is editing.
